Trump's Declarations: A Dangerous Path to Ethnic Cleansing

We, the organizations and individuals of the Global Coalition against the Occupation of Palestine (SANED), strongly condemn the recent statements by the President of the United States of America, Donald Trump, which implicitly advocate for the ethnic cleansing of the Palestinian people. Such rhetoric is not only a violation of international law but also a grave moral failing that must be unequivocally denounced by people of conscience worldwide.

This dangerous discourse reflects an escalation of the irresponsible, colonial, and aggressive policies that have characterized successive U.S. administrations toward oppressed nations and indigenous peoples. Historically, the U.S.-Israel alliance has been built on unconditional support for violent colonial practices against the Palestinian people, perpetuating injustice and dispossession.

SANED views these statements as not only morally reprehensible but also a perilous escalation of dehumanizing rhetoric that undermines the fundamental rights of the Palestinian people to their land. Such rhetoric emboldens Israel to continue its ethnic cleansing policies in occupied Palestine, fuels genocidal actions by the Israeli government—which is under investigation by the International Criminal Court (ICC)—and violates the principles of international law, human rights, and basic human dignity.

The current declarations by the U.S. and Israeli governments stand in direct opposition to the values of justice, equality, and self-determination that should underpin global relations. We warn the international community that the expulsion of the Palestinian people is occurring under the guise of ceasefires, as Gaza and other Palestinian territories are systematically rendered uninhabitable through destruction, siege, killings, and the arming of radical, ideologically driven Israeli settlers.

The Palestinian people, like all peoples, have an inherent right to live in dignity, freedom, and security on their ancestral land. Calls for their displacement constitute a blatant violation of international law and universal human rights principles.

SANED stands in unwavering solidarity with the Palestinian people and all nations enduring oppression, displacement, genocide, and injustice. We call on global leaders to reject the provocative and destructive policies of the U.S. government and to uphold the principles of justice and equality.

We affirm that lasting peace in Palestine can only be achieved through the end of occupation, the dismantlement of the Zionist regime, the recognition of the historical rights of the Palestinian people, their freedom, and their inherent right to live in dignity on their land.
